

REGULAR MEETING OF HETTINGER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

November 5, 2020

Regular meeting of November 5, 2020, 8:30 a.m., all voting in favor and motions carried unless noted otherwise. Members present were Ron Friedt, Angela Carlson and John Plaggemeyer. Also present, Elliott Finck, Road Supervisor and Todd Lutz.

Carlson motioned to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Plaggemeyer.

The board reviewed the fees received from the Sheriff and Records offices.

Plaggemeyer made the motion to approve bills as presented: General 39,112.68; Road & Bridge 30,059.98; E911 7,538.06; County Agent 5653.22; Sheriff 3,979.22; 24/7 Program 522.10. Carlson seconded the motion to approve bills.

Duane Marxen, County Agent, met with the board to give his monthly report. They discussed that we will not hold the open house next month. The decorating of trees is still going to be held and Plaggemeyer motioned to disperse \$100.00 for first place, \$75 for second, and \$25 for third place decorated trees, seconded by Carlson.

Elliott Finck gave the road supervisor report.

Carlson made the motion to have DLN Consulting, Inc. develop a performance appraisal form, the self-evaluation, and interview questions for county employee performance reviews. Plaggemeyer seconded the motion.

Billy Doerr, Brosz Engineering, discussed with the board that the Bentley Bridge is not as bad as earlier stated, according to the NDDOT. It is being looked into whether it should have maintenance done instead of replacement. All engineering done and paid for will be good for any future plans. Funds from the state for the Prairie Dog funding seems to be delayed yet again.

Sheriff Warner gave her monthly Sheriff's report.

Chad Kelsch updated the board on the county's website.

The commissioners tabled the request of support for Powering ND at this time.
