

REGULAR MEETING OF HETTINGER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
June 16, 2021

Chairman Angela Carlson called the meeting to order at 8:45 a.m. with commissioners Todd Lutz and Tom Geerts in attendance. Also present were Sondra Bullinger and Terry Kirschmann.

The Steiner Township cancelled the request of help with funding to do culvert work.

A discussion of the Courthouse Portfolio was held with a request from Geerts to have courthouse issues given to him as the holder of this portfolio.

Lutz motioned to open the position up again for a full-time Tax Director with Terry Kirschmann, Deputy Treasurer, agreeing to step into the position on a trial basis. She will also take the training required so there can be another person who can help with this position. Geerts seconded the motion; all voted "aye", motion carried. Discussion then followed that this position is be placed with the SD Assessors Association, as the assessors work in SD is very similar to North Dakota. Posting of the position will also be with the ND Assessors Association and with the ND Association of Counties.

Geerts wanted to clarify whose responsibility of building expenses it was for the fair building. The county owns the buildings and carries the insurance, but the Hettinger County Activities Association collects the rental fees for activities held there and uses the fees towards their revenues, they will be responsible to take care of the upkeep.
