Staff changes - Meghan Vaughn has accepted the position of Youth Services Specialist at Nola Brantley. Samara Terry (a former employee) has agreed to take the part-time position left by Ms. Vaughn.

On the circulation report, please note the number of volunteer hours – especially at Perry. Also, the total number of Notary services continues to rise.

A tree was donated by former library director Judy Golden in memory of Janet Sayre who was the cataloger for HOUPL for several decades. A dedication ceremony is being planned.

Staff were given trial access to a potential new library service – Kanopy – which is a streaming video service that is affiliated with Overdrive (our ebook and Eaudio provider). Our consortium (GADD – Georgia Download Destination) is considering adding Kanopy to our offerings. We already know the potential cost and it would be paid for out of state funds should we move forward with this.

Staff recognition this month goes to James Floyd, the Branch Manager at Perry. All of the Branch Managers sometimes has to handle "other duties as needed". James Floyd stayed with the carpet cleaners after hours recently and he has gracefully and patiently talked with one of our patrons who on occasion has needed additional attention. Thank you Mr. Floyd!
