


APPROVED BUDGET AND TAX RATE


City of Kemp City Council approved the FY 2023-2024 Budget, which includes a tax rate of \$0.45325 per \$100 assessed value on all taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Kemp. This represents a significant tax savings to the Kemp property owners, a decrease of almost \$.23 per \$100 of taxable property value! Link to Budget Below.
