

PARK PASSES

- Circulate for 7 days
- Non-holdable
- Some are renewable; some are not

INTERLIBRARY LOAN

- Loan duration may vary
- Max loan duration is 28 days
- Some lending agencies may require postage or insurance
- These charges are the responsibility of the patron requesting the material

FINES & FEES

- Fines are applied per day, per item
- The fine limit for all materials except equipment is \$5 per item
- Books, CDs, ILL: \$.20
- DVDs: \$.50
- Equipment: \$10; \$50 limit

MATERIALS & CIRCULATION POLICIES



I have a library card...
...now what?

Here's what you need to know to make the most of your library card and keep your account in good standing.



What does "good standing" mean?

"Good standing" means that you keep up with your card and any fines accrued on your account. You must present your card to obtain materials & services. Cards with **\$10 or more** in fines & fees will be blocked, and no materials or services may be obtained.

What can I check out with my card?

All kinds of things! Different physical materials have different circulation times and different late fees - read on to find out more.

BOOKS, CDS, MAGAZINES

- Circulate for 14 days
- Eligible for 2 renewals
- Renewal requests may be made by phone, in person, or through the PINES app

DVDS

- Circulate for 7 days to patrons 18+
- No more than 2 new releases per patron
- Non-renewable

EQUIPMENT

- Circulate for 24 hours to patrons 18+
- Longer loan periods negotiable
- Security deposits may apply
