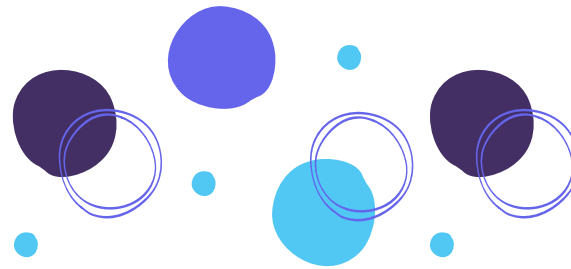

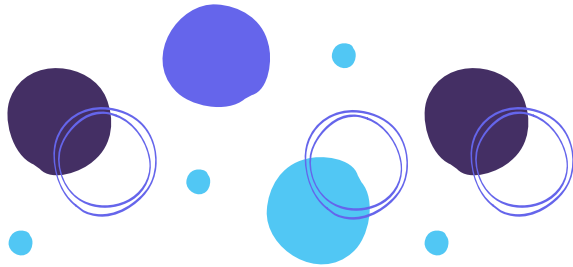

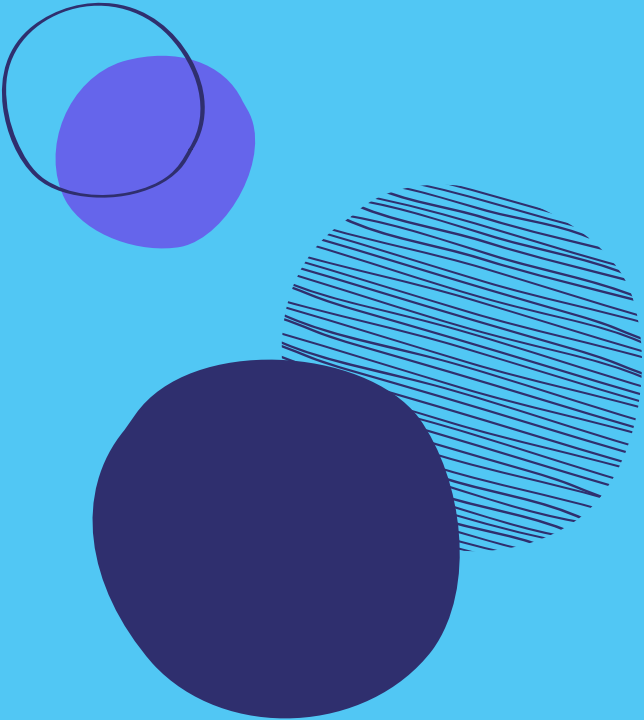

IDENTIFICATION

Proper identification must be presented to register for a PINES card. This includes a drivers' license, passport, or other government-issued identification.

RESIDENTIAL

Persons who attend school, own property or are employed in Georgia are eligible for a free PINES card. Patrons of both PINES and non-PINES Georgia public libraries may receive a PINES card.

LOST CARD

PINES cards are valid for 2 years, after which point the original card may be renewed for another two years. If a patron loses their card, the fee for a replacement card is \$2.00.

OUT OF STATE

Out-of-state cards are available to persons living outside Georgia who do not meet the criteria for a temporary card. There is a fee of \$25.00, payable at the time the card is issued, and the card is valid for one year.

AGE

There is no minimum age for a child to receive a PINES card, but a parent or legal guardian must sign the application and have proper identification if the child is under 18.

TEMPORARY

Persons who will be in Georgia for less than 6 months, and reside outside Georgia, may be issued a temporary card. Privilege limit is 6 months. The fee is \$12.50 payable at the time the card is issued.
