Emergency Medical Technician, Advanced EMT, or Paramedic

The Madawaska Emergency Medical Services is accepting applications for a full-time position as an Emergency Medical Technician. The selected applicant will be responsible to provide patient care in the prehospital environment, including, but not limited to, assessing the patient, performing CPR, handling emergencies utilizing life support equipment and procedures within the specific licensure level the applicant has previously acquired. As well as aiding the town departments upon request in an emergency situation.

The candidate must have one of the following qualifications:

- **EMT Basic:** Applicants must hold a current and valid State of Maine EMT-B license and motor vehicle operator's license.
- **Advanced EMT:** Applicants must hold a current and valid State of Maine A-EMT license and motor vehicle operator's license.
- **Paramedic:** Applicants must hold a current and valid State of Maine EMT-P license and motor vehicle operator's license.

Applicants are expected to be open to learning, possess good communication skills, and be able to work in a team environment. To perform the job, the ability to meet the State of Maine recommended physical and skill requirements is a must.
