GOVERNING AND ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION

- Section 1. Elections:
The secret ballot, or Australian Ballot, will be used for the election of Town Officers, in accordance with the provisions of Sections 38 to 52, Chapter 5, R.S. of Maine, 1930.
- Section 2. Legislative Body:
The Town of Madawaska will elect a Board of five Selectmen, Assessors, and Overseers of the Poor.
- Section 3. Manager Appointment and Compensation:
The Selectmen and Overseers of the Poor are authorized to employ a Town Manager in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 80, Sections 16 to 22 inclusive of the Revised Statutes of Maine, 1944.
Compensation to the Town Manager to be fixed by Selectmen.
- Section 4. Fiscal Year Ending:
Ending date of Municipal Year changed from the last day of February of each year to the last day of January of each year.
- Section 5. Maine Workmen's Compensation:
The Town of Madawaska accepts the provisions of the Maine Workmen's Compensation Act, Chapter 26 of the R.S., 1944, of the State of Maine.
- Section 6. By-Laws and Ordinances:
Adopted as ordinance for the Town of Madawaska Chapter 80, Section 83 of the R.S., of Maine, 1944.
