* Craig Askim %NDSU Ext. reported that yesterday he got word that a hazardous Poultry Flu has been found in South Dakota. He wanted the responders to be aware if there are any cases in our county we will need to take specific measures to get rid of animals and remains. He will keep Carmen updated & she will send out this information to all Law Enforcement & Fire Chiefs so they are aware of the situation as it unfolds.

* Mercer MHMP Update: All initial Hazards have been completed with the Cities & County. Members were asked to look at the information and let Carmen know if you have any updates. The Public survey is in the local papers this week. Carmen has one more email that will be sent out to the City Auditors for information regarding Key facilities & growth within the community (number of structures). Once that information is collected then a draft plan will be developed. Once the draft plan is completed, it will be emailed out to all members for review. We will also be having a Public hearing to review this plan with the public.

* **2022 Exercise Set Date and finalize the Type/Scenario:** The DGC tabletop exercise was approved and it is tentatively planned to take place in June.

***SIRN Radio & NG911 Projects Update:** The SIRN Project is in the process of installation since early March and it will continue through possibly June.

***Other Items/Discussion:**


- ✳ **Burn Bans were discussed and it was decided to not put any burn ban on until necessary.**
