A LETTER FROM YOUR TOWN MANAGER, MARY CRIPE, P.E.

We welcome summer in Middlebury. Ushering in the summer season is the Summer Festival. For 55 years, Middlebury has hosted family and friends from around the region to celebrate our heritage, take in some entertainment, enjoy a parade, and share some festival food. We hope to see you there!!

Just as in recent years, construction in and around Middlebury will be prevalent. The Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) will continue with the construction of US 20 from SR 15 to CR 37 with an anticipated completion date in late August 2024. INDOT will also be making safety improvements at the US 20 and SR 13 intersection. Elkhart County will be improving CR 22 from CR 35 to CR 37 and CR 20 from CR 37 to SR 13 with a traffic signal to be installed at SR 13 and CR 20 in 2025. Middlebury will be reconstructing Bluebird Lane and East Warren Street and building the new River Mill Trail to connect Riverbend Park to the Pumpkinvine Nature Trail.

Hopefully, you have time to enjoy the natural beauty of our parks as we transition into summer. There are so many moments in life that we may miss if we are too busy to notice. Take the time to put down electronic devices and get out in nature.




