

ORDINANCE No. 66.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ANY CHICKEN, DUCKS, GEESE, TURKEY, OR OTHER DOMESTIC FOWLS TO RUN AT LARGE, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF MIDDLEBURY, INDIANA, AND PRESCRIBING A PENALTY FOR ANY VIOLATION THEREOF.

Sec. 1. Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Town of Middlebury, Elkhart County, Indiana. That it shall be unlawful for any person, persons, company or Corporation, who shall be the owner, or have in his or her, or their care and custody, any chicken, ducks, geese, trurkey or other domestic fowl , to allow any such fowl above named, to run at large upon any street or alley, or upon any inclosed or un-iclosed lot or lots or parcel of land of another, within the corporate limits of the town of Middlebury, Indiana, between the 1st day of April and the 1st day of November, of any year.

Sec. 2. Any person, persons, company or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not less than one (\$1.00) dollar nor more than ten (\$10.00) dollars,

Sec. 3. It shall be the duty of the marshal or the street commissioner of said town to enforce any and all provisions of this ordinance, and shall proceed to prosecute any person, persons, company or corporation found violating any of the provisions herein set forth.

Sec. 4. Whereas there is an emergency existing for the immedidate taking effect of this ordinance , Be it therefore further Ordained that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage. And this Ordinance shall be published in the Middlebury Ind-

ependent. a news paper of general circulation, printed and published  
in the town of Middlebury, Indiana, for two consecutive weeks.
