Mullin's Head Park
Camping Ordinance

1. To limit the use of camping on town-owned land known as Mullin's Head Park to taxpayers or residents of the Town of North Haven, Maine and their immediate family and guests. Camping is prohibited on any other town land.
2. Camping and tenting shall be limited to the designated area and to only 7 (seven) consecutive days. The use of recreational vehicles is prohibited.
3. With fire being a great concern on North Haven, charcoal and gas grills are permitted, but NO OPEN FIRES ARE PERMITTED without the express written consent of the Fire Chief, or his representative. Users shall be responsible for any destruction of town property or other criminal acts punishable by law.
4. Permission to use the area must be obtained in advance from the town office by a taxpayer or resident and will be granted on a space available basis. Limit of 12 individuals. Donations accepted.
5. The camping area must be policed daily by the users and all trash deposited in the available containers. "Carry in and carry out" is encouraged.
6. Failure to comply with these provisions shall result in the revocation of the right to use the camping area. All other provisions of the park shall apply.
7. Enforcement. Any park commissioner or law enforcement officer shall have full authority to enforce the provisions of this ordinance. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 (ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS) or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days or both.
