As of April 2023 Find A Grave lists **680** memorials in this cemetery.

This transcription is done geographically based on a hand-drawn map (circa 1980) by Charles Candage which is located in the Owls Head Town Office. The map has not been updated or corrected since then and some lots/boundaries are unclear.

The transcription begins in Section 1, Lot 1, in the far southwest corner (upper left from road) and goes across by row.

There are nearly 80 burials without headstones (NM). Many have been added to lots where they are most likely buried based on genealogy and/or cemetery file card notes. Dowsing in some areas of the cemetery was done by the Owls Head Cemetery Committee in April of 2023 to attempt to verify some of the information regarding unmarked burials. Notes have been added below.
