

## Adas Yoshuron Cemetery

### *Location*

This cemetery is located on the east side of Route 73, about 0.25 mile north of North Shore Dr.

### *Description*

The Adas Yoshuron Cemetery is a private cemetery maintained by the Adas Yoshuron Cemetery Association. The earliest gravestone here is 1908 and the cemetery is still being used.

### *Transcription Notes*

This cemetery was transcribed by an unknown individual and those records can be found in the J. Gary Nichols Cemetery Collection. Heather Almquist recorded the following transcript in 2021. The transcription proceeds row by row from the road to the back on the north (left) side, and row by row from back to front on the south (right) side.
