Additional Note:

During Owls Head Cemetery Committee conservation project Sept. 4-7, 2022 two people dowsed the cemetery. The result is that it appears that there are MANY folks buried in the cemetery without headstones. Virtually every "empty" space may contain a burial. It's possible that the far left, middle to rear section was a Potter's Field.

During the conservation project in September of 2022 a rusted military medallion/cross from the Spanish American War was found buried beneath the headstone of Angie Rackliff in the far back of the cemetery. I cannot find a veteran of that war in this cemetery. The most likely, based on age, are Adrian Hooper, Ethelbert Maddocks, Francis Maddocks, Vinal Perry, and Arthur Tolman. None of them appear to have served in the military.
