Asenath (Paul) Wife (1 of 3) of Samuel B. **Perry**, Departed this life June 6, 1840; Aged 29 years and 10 months.

Frank B. **Perry** Son of S. B. & Asenath Perry, died Sept. 17, 1863, AE. 24 yrs. 10 mos. & 1 day

Julia E. (Perry) **Kalloch** Died July 28, 1888, AE. 53 y's 8 m's & 28 d s. (Divorced wife of Amariah Kalloch.)

Emma E. (Perry) Wife of Rufus **Arey** 2d Died April 2, 1869, AE. 27 y's. 2 m's. & 1 day.

Edward Hamilton, son of Robert C. and Frances H. (Ingraham) **Brann**, died Nov. 26, 1852, AE. 8 mos. (Parents moved to San Francisco, CA)

Albert H. **Ingraham** 1853-1916

Fannie B. (Hinkley) His Wife 1856-1925 (March 12, 1925, AE. 68/5/22)

***Note:**

Believed to be Joseph **Guptill**, b. 16 Dec 1821 in East Thomaston to Nathaniel & Eleanor (Spear) Guptill. Joseph Guptill is listed in the 1860 & 1870 Census for S. Thomaston as being a laborer for Bernard Ingraham. According to the 1880 Census, after Bernard died Joseph worked for his son, Bernard B. Ingraham. "J. Guptill" is buried next to Carrie Ingraham, daughter of BBI which may be meaningful.

Buried here without markers (based on Charles Candage transcription):

Mary Ann Ingraham **Butler**, b. April 12, 1817, d. April 1, 1892 Her death record (ST) states burial at Ingraham Hill. Her parents Isaac & Susannah and many Ingraham family members are in this cemetery.

Orris Robbins **Butler**, her husband b. June 15, 1813, d. Dec. 24, 1902. Presumed to be buried together.

Likely buried here, without markers:

Bernard Boyce **Ingraham** 1822-1906 Should have been listed on the family obelisk with father and grandfather. This is his family's cemetery.

Elizabeth C. McIntosh **Ingraham**, his wife, 1829-1922 Her death record states burial in the Ingraham Hill cemetery. She and Bernard must be buried here in the family cemetery. Both of her parents and their 3 children are here.

John Murray **Small** b. 1856 (Deer Isle) d. 12 Aug 1922 (RKD). RKD dr states burial at Ingraham, but CG obit (lists Burpee Funeral Home) and OH dr (copy) state burial at Ingraham Hill. On FaG in this cemetery.

Melvina **Ingraham**, infant daughter of Bernard & Hannah, b. May 10, 1818, d. August 18, 1820 (Eaton's, Vol II, p. 277)
