**Likely burials, without headstones:**

Annie Eliza Jones Collins **Deane** (1870 - 24 Apr. 1941) is likely buried here with her first husband (Wm A. Collins) and son (Charles Wm. Collins). OH dr #214 states burial at "Ingraham". CG obit (4/26/41) mentions interment in family lot in Owls Head. LHC added to FaG 11/2022

William A. **Collins** b. 30 Mar 1869 d. 14 Dec 1921 Son Charles is here and his wife Annie Collins Deane is likely here. His Rockland dr states burial in Owls Head at Hall Cemetery. LHC added to FaG 11/2022.

**The following have Find A Grave memorials in this cemetery but there are NO records to support that claim:**

Jeremiah **Philbrook**, Jr. 1777 - 1861 (his wife's (Hannah) burial location is also unknown. It is possible that there are Philbrook family members buried on their former property off Great Marsh Lane where daughter Malvena is believed to be buried.

Julia G. Philbrook **Ash** 1815 - 1895 Wife of Nathaniel Ash (@ Hall Cemetery), Dau. Of Jeremiah & Hannah (Hersey) Philbrook. ST Dr states burial at Hix.

Joseph W. **Philbrook** son of Jeremiah & Hannah 1818 - 1903 (second wife Mary Jane Cook is buried here)

Levi T. **Philbrook** son of Jeremiah & Hannah 1823 - 1841
