V - Veteran: 3 (possibly 4 (Pillsbury), see note at end)

There are **89** records/graves on Find A Grave in this cemetery. **18** do not have a headstone or marker. The oldest burial would be for Nathan S. **Pillsbury** (1832) if he is in fact buried here (no headstone) and the last was Phyllis Additon **Russell** (1990).

History: Evidently this cemetery existed in 1832, though perhaps it was established even earlier. There is reference to this cemetery in a deed (Book 29/ Page 264) dated January 1, 1872, when George W. Emery sold land to Eben Small "reserving one half acre where the graveyard is now located with the right to and from the same".

This transcription is organized geographically, across rows (left to right) from West (far) side of cemetery to the East. Most headstones are facing West.

Mary M. (Rackliff) Wife of Capt. W. C. **Maddocks** Died May 9, 1887, AE. 77 y's & 10 m's.

Winthrop C. **Maddocks**, Died Nov. 22, 1860, AE. 53 yrs. 5 mos. & 22 dys.

Possible burials here:

V Dea. Nathan **Pillsbury** 1760 (Elliot, Maine) - 23 May 1826 (Ash Point) He was a Revolutionary War Patriot. (Eaton's, Vol. II, p. 358). He married Lucy Emery in 1788.

The Bicentennial Inscription Project (BIP) listed him as being 1 of 10 patriots buried in Owls Head (location unknown). His son Joseph and grandson Nathan are buried here.

Lucy Emery **Pillsbury** (1764-1832?), wife of Nathan and sister of George Emery (1763-1846) who is buried here.

Stephen **Post** Jr. 25 Feb 1781 (Eaton's), died between 1840-1850 in ST. Son Enoch buried here.

Mary/Mercy Orbeton, wife of Stephen **Post** 1789 - 20 Feb 1864

Nancy Sleeper, first wife of Geo. W. **Emery** 1801 - 1825/6
