

BUDGET SESSION OF THE PAMLICO COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

MONDAY, JUNE 14, 2021

The Pamlico County Board of Commissioners met on Monday, June 14, 2021 in the Patsy H. Sadler room for a budget workshop. All Commissioners were present. Also present were County Manager Tim Buck, Finance Officer Bill Fentress, and Clerk to the Board Courtney L. Norfleet.

On a motion made by Commissioner Candy Bohmert and seconded by Commissioner Pat Prescott, the meeting was called to order.

On a motion made by Commissioner Missy Baskervill and seconded by Commissioner Candy Bohmert, the Board met in closed session pursuant to NCGS §143-318.11(a)(6).

On a motion made by Commissioner Ed Riggs and seconded by Commissioner Candy Bohmert, the Board recessed for five (5) minutes.

On a motion made by Commissioner Candy Bohmert and seconded by Commissioner Missy Baskervill, the Board went back into open session.

BE IT RESOLVED, the request to enter into contract with Communicable Disease Nurse is hereby approved.

BE IT RESOLVED, the request to raise the hiring rate of nurses to \$55,000 is hereby approved.
