



**BUDGET MEETING/ BOH TRAINING MINUTES OF THE  
PAMLICO COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
MONDAY, MAY 6, 2024**

The Pamlico County Board of Commissioners held a Budget Meeting/BOH Training on Monday, May 6, 2024, at 5:30 in the Patsy H. Sadler room of the Pamlico County Courthouse. Commissioners Missy Baskervill, Candy Bohmert, Doug Brinson, Kari Forrest, Pat Prescott, and Ed Riggs were present. Commissioner Carl Ollison arrived a few minutes after the start of the meeting. Also present were County Manager Tim Buck, and Clerk to the Board Tracy Boyd. This meeting was open to the public, and proper notice was given.

Chairman Bohmert called the meeting back to order at 5:35pm (recessed from the Budget Meeting on May 3, 2024).

The purpose of the meeting was to provide Board of Health Annual Training on:

1. Public Health Ethics
2. Introduction to Public Health in North Carolina
3. Public Health Framework Equity in Public Health
4. North Carolina Public Health Organizational Structure
5. The Future of Public Health in North Carolina

Lynn Hardison from Pamlico County Health Department discussed the following objectives:

1. Describing the work of public health.
2. Describing the state and federal public health infrastructure.
3. Identifying the policies and legislation that guide the work of public health in North Carolina.
4. Explaining the purpose of the 3 Core Functions and 10 Essential Public Health Service framework.
5. Explain what systematic racism is and its impact on health outcomes.
6. Identify the role of public health in addressing health equity.
7. Explaining the governance structure in North Carolina's public health system.
8. Summarizing the key differences between the ethical approaches of the critical and public health professions.
9. Describing the APHA Public Health Code of Ethics' considerations and their application to decision-making.
10. Considering different theoretical perspectives to apply to ethical dilemmas.
11. Using an eight-step procedure to critically consider ethical issues in public health practice.

The board discussed adding the policy and procedures, and updating the Commissioner's information in the Pamlico Board of Health Handbook. The board also discussed the purchase of a new car for DSS.

No actions were taken.
