

Pamlico County Planning Board Meeting Minutes June 29, 2004

The Pamlico County Planning Board held its regularly scheduled meeting on June 29, 2004 in the Courthouse Annex. Present at the meeting were Nick Santoro - 3/3, Jimmy Spain - 3/3, Vernon Rose - 3/3, Denard Potter 3/3 and John Buck, III - 3/2. Also in attendance was Arey Grady, Attorney to the Board and Skip Lee, Secretary to the Board. Vice-Chairman, Nick Santoro called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.

The first item on the agenda was the minutes of the March 30, 2004 meeting. Denard Potter made the motion to approve the minutes as written, and Jimmy Spain seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Josh Nobles was next on the agenda presenting Maple Leaf Subdivision, a 7-lot subdivision off of Hwy 304. Vernon Rose made a motion to approve the plat subject to the current owner's name being placed on it, and Jimmy Spain seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

The Campground Ordinance was next on the agenda under old business. The members decided to wait and discuss the ordinance at the next meeting.

New business was next on the agenda. The election of officers was discussed, and a motion was made by Nick Santoro to wait until the next meeting, and Dr. Rose seconded the motion. The motion carried with all members voting to approve, with the exception of John Buck, III.

Denard Potter made a motion to adjourn the meeting, and John Buck, III seconded. All members voted in favor of the motion. The meeting adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
