MOTION Wojan, Second West to approve February 1, 2014 regular meeting minutes. All approved.

Committee Reports -

Building Committee – the fireplace, electrical, HVAC will be nearing completion mid April. Later part of April tile work, electrical finishes, and painting are expected to be done. The old terminal will not be moved this year due to budget constraints. Interiors committee will be meeting April 17th to discuss budget and prioritize what items can be purchased based on funds available.

Terminal Lease Negotiations Sub Committee – The final negations on the new lease have been completed. The next step is for it to be reviewed by the BIAC lawyer and if acceptable approved at next meeting.

MOTION Wojan, Second West to send Terminal Lease Agreement to BIAC lawyer for review. All approved.

Minimum Standards – Elaine West with assistance from Rachel Teague will review and present a report at next meeting.

New business -

MOTION West, Second Wojan to accept Mead & Hunt consultant proposal. All approved.

Election of Officers was tabled for next meeting.

Stephanie Ward of Mead & Hunt provided a summary of current and future project budgets. Various reimbursements are expected from MDOT for items such as phone line and electrical line changes. These maybe allocated to The parking lot project had several overruns that has created a deficit. The Apron project will have to be reduced to try to keep it within the grant amount. Tree clearing for the approach will come from local funds. Will look at removing the old terminal in 2015 when more funds are available.

Motion West, Second Lodico to delay the removal of the old terminal building. All approved.

Motion West, Second Lodico to consider a displaced threshold of a 100 ft to assist with the tree issues and continue negations with Banvilles for the removal of trees that affect the approach to runway 27.

Elaine West has received letters of support from both townships for a \$25,000 Tribal grant which would be used for furnishings. A response should be expected by mid July.
