Beaver Island Transfer Station and Recycle Center offers residents, non-residents and commercial customers a safe, clean and environmentally friendly location to dispose of all solid waste and recyclables.

The Beaver Island Transfer Station and Recycle Center is jointly operated by Peaine and St. James Townships. Oversight is the responsibility of the seven member BI Waste Management Committee, composed of residents from Peaine and St. James Townships. Minutes and agendas may be found on township websites. Manager of the BI Transfer Station and Recycle Center is Robert Marsh.

Disposal of Garbage, Recyclables & Green Bags

The Townships of Peaine and St. James utilize a pay-per-bag program for resident self-haulers only. The townships provides no garbage pickup services. Residents and visitors bring their household garbage and recyclables to the joint township-operated transfer and recycling center.

Recyclables

All recyclables should be transported separately and placed in the appropriate areas at the Transfer Station. Recyclables such as aluminum, corrugated cardboard, mixed paper, cans, glass bottles, plastics, and scrap metal are accepted at no cost to residents or non-residents

Green Garbage Bags

All household garbage must be placed in a Green Beaver Island Garbage Bag

- Fees for garbage disposal are included in the price of the Green BI Garbage Bag
- Green BI Garbage Bags are to be used for household garbage only
- Green BI Garbage Bags costs: Large Bag, \$4.00 (50 gallon) & Medium Bag \$2.50 (30 gallon)
- BI Green Garbage Bags are available for purchase from local stores:
 - Peaine Township: Island Energies & BI Transfer Station and Recycle Center
 - St. James Township: Mc Donough's Market & Power's Do it Best Hardware

Garbage NOT placed in Green Bags, a surcharge of up to \$5 applies

Other Waste

Additional information about disposal of C&D materials, household hazardous waste, metal, yard and electronic waste and other household and bulk items, as well as fees and tipping charges are available by consulting the attached chart or by calling or visiting the Transfer Station.

Hours of Operation

- May - October Monday through Saturday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Closed: Sundays and Holidays
- November - April Monday through Saturday, 11a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Closed Sundays and Holidays
- Holidays: Good Friday, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Years
- After hours special hoppers available for disposal of Green Bags only.
- NO after hours recycling available.
