Meeting called to order at 7:05 pm

Chairman Geo Honigford introduced the idea of using Roberts Rules for Small Board instead of the more formal Roberts Rules of Order. Motion made to accept Roberts Rules for Small Boards, by Stuart, seconded by Peter. Passed by Unanimous vote.

Geo asked for ideas for setting goals for the upcoming year, discussion followed in the form of a brain storming session on ideas for goals which were suggested as follows, ATV Update, Flood Hazards, Class 4 road usage, Development on Class 4 roads. Master plan for the village, Capital Budget, River Access, bike Trails, no central messaging on the green.

Geo presented ideas for Flood Hazard meeting in September. Geo will ask White River Partnership to preview the public meeting information next RPC meeting. Set date for a public meeting on September 6th.

Action items for RPC are as follows: Contact Walter about the Academy building, (Geo); Contact WRP, (Geo); What do neighboring towns do for Flood Plain Planning, (Bushrod); Contact VLS for an ELC contact, (Sarah);

Sarah Danley gave an update for the Future Planning exercise. The study area is larger than just the village, to include town offices area, the Terrace, South Windsor street, North Windsor street. There will be two public meetings on the plan, first on September 22nd at 6:30 PM on what should be in the area and the second meeting set for October 24th on what will 'fit' in the area.

Nell Gwin gave an update on the Underpass Arts Project, The news is the Railroad permit has been issued. Last month an AARP grant was obtained as well to be combined with the Better Places grant and crowd funding for the implementation of the Safford Street Arts Project.
