Reports To: Public Works Director

Definition: Under general supervision performs a variety of duties including but not limited to the removal and disposal of any un-safe or illegally dumped items along City Streets, Rights of Ways, alleys or public areas that may constitute a public safety hazard or nuisance. Will work closely with the general public to inform, educate and update property owners of City Ordinances, policies or procedures as needed. Will keep easements and right of ways clear of trash, weeds, and remove overhanging tree limbs as needed. Assist Senior Maintenance Tech with projects and any other department as needed. Non- Exempt FLSA.

Essential Functions: Essential functions, as defined under the Americans with Disabilities Act, may include the following tasks, knowledge, skills, and other characteristics. This list of tasks is ILLUSTRATIVE ONLY, and is not a comprehensive listing of all functions and tasks performed by positions in this class.

Tasks: While operating in a safe manner the Maintenance Tech I will on a daily manner use the department truck to ensure that any rubbish, trash, furniture, appliances, or other illegally discarded items are removed and disposed from the City rights of way, City streets, alleys or other public areas that may result in an unsafe or unhealthy concern to the Public. All substantial illegal dumping activities will be documented and photographed, and the information will be given to the Code Compliance Officers.

May cut weeds or tree branches on specific Rights of Ways to improve visibility for vehicular as well as pedestrian traffic. Disposes of any cuttings in an appropriate manner.

Will provide education as needed to property owners about the services provided by the solid waste collector including brush removal schedules and recycling events.

May post signage and hand out flyers as needed by both Public Works and Planning and Zoning.

The Maintenance Tech I will assist the Senior Maintenance Tech with general building maintenance and repair projects.

Responsible for grease trap inspections and records.

Prepares and maintains all necessary daily or weekly departmental reports or paperwork.

Responsible for maintenance of assigned vehicle.

Performs other related duties as needed or assigned as well as mandatory cross training within the Public Works Department.

Working Environment: Outside and inside environment, travel within City limits. Noise level could be moderate in work environment. May be outside in adverse weather conditions.

Knowledge, Skills, and Other Characteristics:

Skills in communicating with businesses and private citizens regarding solid waste and grease trap inspection, codes and ordinances

Knowledge of compliance procedures for City solid waste codes

Skills in understanding and interpreting complex regulations and guidelines

Skill in communicating in person and in writing
Skill in handling confrontational conversations and situations.
Skill in establishing and maintaining routine working relationships with citizens, public officials, outside agencies, property owners and businesses.
Skill in operating gas powered equipment such as weed trimmers, mowers, chain saws or other small engine equipment in a safe manner.

Physical Demands

Ability to maintain physical condition and stamina appropriate to the performance of assigned duties and responsibilities which may include sitting, standing, or walking for extended periods of time, driving or riding in vehicle or other duties as assigned.

Frequently required to reach with hands and arms, climb or balance, stoop, kneel, bend or squatting.

Pushing, pulling, lifting and/or moving over 50 pounds.
