

PROJECT GOOD MORNING RULES

1. You MUST live alone, or with another person who is unable to render you assistance in an emergency.
2. You MUST not be in regular contact with another person.
3. You MUST reside in the Town of Sandwich.
4. You MUST call the Selectmen's Office ((603) 284-7701) Monday-Thursday between 9:00 AM and 10:00 AM. On Fridays, please call the Sandwich Police Department ((603) 284-7139).
5. You MUST notify the Selectmen's Office if you will be away. For example, if you are going to be away from home, in the hospital, leaving early in the morning, etc., you must let us know you will not be calling in on those days.

PROJECT GOOD MORNING GUIDELINES

A. Project Good Morning (PGM) participants complete an application for admittance into the program. This application is an agreement by both parties involved to abide by the rules of the program, and the information contained therein will be used in the event of an emergency.

B. Project Good Morning participants call the Selectmen's Office at (603) 284-7701, located at 8 Maple Street, in Center Sandwich between the hours of 9:00 AM and 10:00 AM, Monday through Thursday. In the event the Selectmen's Office is closed, the PGM participant will be given a number to call in advance. If the PGM participant is going to be away from home, in the hospital, leaving early in the morning, etc., they may simply notify the Selectmen's Office in advance with the dates they will be away.

C. At 10:00 AM, the Selectmen's Office will verify that all program participants have called. If a PGM participant has not called in, the Selectmen's Office will attempt to call the participant by telephone to assure their well-being. If the Selectmen's Office cannot reach the participant by telephone, a police officer will be dispatched to the participant's residence.

AGREEMENT

I understand and agree with the guidelines for participation in Project Good Morning.

I understand the purpose of the program is to provide me with a sense of security and independence, and the Sandwich Police Department will not provide taxi or errand services.

I understand that if I do not call, the Selectmen's Office will:

1. Call my residence, and if they receive no answer will;
2. Dispatch a police officer to my residence to check on my well-being.

I understand if I do not answer the door and the officer reasonably believes that I may be inside and in need of assistance, the officer will use whatever force is necessary to gain entry into my residence.

I understand participating in Project Good Morning is a privilege, and the Sandwich Police Department reserves the right to discontinue the service should I abuse the intent of the program.

I understand the Sandwich Police Department and New Hampshire State Police accepts no responsibility for damages caused in entering my residence under the above stated conditions and agree to all of the terms and conditions set forth in this application.
