There were no guests this evening. Anna reported seeing Piliated Woodpeckers routinely in her yard. A Bobcat was seen walking along the Northern boundary of her property, crossing Town Farm Rd., and returning later in the day presumably to return to it's den.

As of Jan.1, 2019 there are no funds left in our budget. All funds were used to purchase rip rap for the Goose Pond Overlook hiking trail project that was completed by the Acton Shapleigh Youth Conservation Corp last summer. We plan to ask for \$250.00 for operating expenses in 2019 at our town meeting in March.

Our Conservation Trail still needs much more work to be done on it. Darren Rogers has volunteered to cut trees that have fallen on the old Town Farm foundation.

Three Rivers Land Trust will hold it's Great Maine Outdoor Weekend celebration on Sat., Feb. 9th from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM. A winter tree identification walk will be offered and refreshments will be served.

Weather permitting, we plan to schedule several walks through the town forest to view our Conservation Trail and plan work projects.
