

TOWN OF SHAPLEIGH'S POLICY

Williams Property Use

Adopted: November 15, 2022

The Williams Town Park is a 300-acre parcel of land donated in 2011 to the Town of Shapleigh by Roger K. Williams and is open for public recreation. The main access to the park is located off County Road, the trails can also be accessed from Gulf Road. In order to maintain the beauty of the land and the safety to all that visit the land, the following rules have been instituted:

Pedestrian traffic only

No motorized vehicles of any kind beyond the gate, unless equipment is actively being used in the maintenance of the property

Carry out anything that you brought in, NO Littering!

Dogs are permitted on leash - their waste must be picked up and carried out.

No fires or use of grills

No fireworks

No smoking

No consumption or sales of drugs or alcohol

No large gatherings without prior written approval from the Board of Selectmen

No overnight parking or camping without prior written approval from the Board of Selectmen

Trapping is allowed by written permission only from the Board of Selectmen.
Annual approval is required

Park hours: Sunrise to sunset daily
