The wait is over! If you have an Amazon Kindle, you can now download e-books to from the library. Simply visit www.swgrl.org and download the e-books to your Kindle anytime.

You can check out and download e-books and audiobooks with a valid library card and password. Once you check out the items, you can transfer them to a long list of compatible devices that

include the Amazon Kindle, Barnes and Noble Nook, Sony Reader, iPod, iPad, and many others. To transfer your downloaded titles to your Kindle, you will need to log in to your Amazon.com account. Users will need to install either Adobe Digital Editions or Overdrive Media Console to download e-books and/or audiobooks for all other devices.

Titles automatically

expire at the end of 7 or 14 days. There are no late fees associated with these materials! You can download all types of materials, including best-sellers, non-fiction, mysteries, romance novels, and much more.

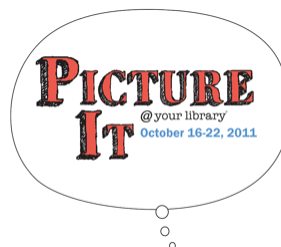
Celebrate Teen Read Week October 17–23
