UTILITY BILL DETAILS



Water/Sewer/Trash bills are mailed by the 1st of every month and are due the 15th of the month.
After the 15th a late fee is applied to the existing amount on the account.
Termination of services for nonpayment shall occur on the 25th of the month, WITHOUT NOTICE, except
when said day falls on a Friday, Saturday, Sunday, or a federally recognized holiday.
When the 25th falls on said days, the termination of services for nonpayment shall occur
on the next regularly scheduled business day.

COLD WEATHER CHECKLIST FOR YOUR HOME

-  **SEAL WINDOWS AND DOORS**
Use caulking to seal windows and weather stripping for doors.
-  **INSULATE PIPES**
Insulate all pipes in laundry room, bathroom or kitchen on exterior walls
-  **TEST SMOKE ALARMS**
House fires pose an additional risk during the winter months when alternative heating sources are used. Also, have a fire extinguisher on hand.
-  **INSPECT ATTIC INSULATION**
If your attic and crawlspaces are not already insulated, consider installing it.
