The Charlevoix County Office of Emergency Management and Networks Northwest are working to update the County's multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, which must be updated every 5 years in order for communities to apply for pre-disaster, hazard mitigation grant funds from FEMA.

Hazards such as severe weather, wildfires, floods, invasive species and public health emergencies can have a significant impact on our families and our communities. These sessions are an opportunity to help identify and reduce your community's vulnerability to natural hazards – and thus reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property.
