Account	Monthly Highlights
General Fund:	The majority of this revenue is from property taxes. This fund has received \$100,000.00 or reimbursement the Waterways Commission grant which has arrived; this amount was load for cash-flow purposes to complete the fuel pier and electrical work at the municipal marine Expect the general fund expenditures to be increased by up to \$15,000 for expenditures related to campground project. Also expect expenditures for improvements at Harbor View Park match and take advantage of Charlevoix County Parks Grant of \$10,000. From this fund board approved an expenditure of \$12,500 for federal broadband grant and local fiber pand \$8,000 for broadband pools of service project.
Street & Road:	Basic monthly expenditures. All revenue for this fund comes from millage levied annually December. Expect to spend money approximately \$19,000 soon for Maple Street resurfact and two road shoulder parking projects. Also, expect to see expenditure of approximately \$9,000 for cement work for boat trailer and vehicle parking across from marina north.
Municipal Dock:	This fund transferred \$100,000.00 as a reimbursement to the GF as the Waterways Commiss grant has arrived; this amount was loaned for cash-flow purposes to complete the fuel pier of electrical work at the municipal marinas. An additional \$67,000 from the Waterways Commission Grant will remain in this fund for the township share of marina improvem projects. Much of seasonal slip money is in. The JAW Foundation continues to provide extens funding for improvements and fuel at the north dock.
Sewer Use:	This fund does not receive tax dollars. All sewer users continue to pay in a timely mann Annual sewer study to be completed soon and new rates went into effect in January. Go news here, this year the historic borrowing debt to the street and road fund will be paid off will the CSB historic loan. This means funds can then begin accumulating for improvements the system.
Sewer Capital Improvement:	This fund does not receive tax dollars. This fund is set up to save money for capital improvement projects related to the sanitary sewer.
Lighthouse:	This fund is set up to save money for improvements to the Whiskey Point Lighthouse. Need assess painting tower in 2021.  I have added a second page to this report which gives board members a snapshot

Charlevoix State Bank funds and an asset summary. Summer Tax bills have been sent out – these are primarily the 6 mills of State Education Tax Levy that all property owners in MI pay.



### Natural Resources Trust Fund (michigan.gov)

- Michigan's Natural Resources Trust Fund Program objective: The Michigan Natural Resources Trust
  Fund (MNRTF) projects provide for natural resource protection and outdoor recreation. By law, no less
  than 25 percent of the Trust Fund amount available for annual appropriation can be used for acquisition
  of public land and no less than 25 percent of the Trust Fund can be used for development of public
  recreation facilities. Final grant recommendations are made by the MNRTF Board to the state legislature
  for final approval.
- The MNRTF grants money for acquisition and for development projects
- Notes of Conversation with Michigan DNR Grants Coordinator Alex McBride
  - IMORTANT NEW NOTE: State communication to St James Twp is that the DNR internal grant team has approved the acceptance of a Time-Sensitive Land Acquisition request. They have sent us the application and Cynthia Pryor and I have reviewed the document and feel able to complete the application the July 27, 2022 deadline.
  - $\circ$  The typical schedule for pursuing an <u>MNRTF Grant</u> is through an annual application process with a March 31 deadline; the process can take 1-1.5 years. If there is a purchase agreement with a willing seller, the state will work closely with the municipality to see the process through.
  - o There is an <u>out-of-cycle process</u> for acquisitions only; this process typically takes 2-3 months if the state feels the project is worthy of funding.
    - There is a 25% match requirement
    - McBride to share information about this project with John Mayes, grant director to gauge his opinion of whether this may warrant an out-of-cycle request
    - Out-of-cycle requests are typically pursued when a piece of property is likely to be sold and developed in a way that precludes it from being use for natural resources protection and outdoor recreation in the future.
      - A strong case would have to be made for this to be considered for out-of-cycle
  - Must have an approved Recreation Plan
  - o Little Traverse Conservancy may be able to help with writing the proposal to MNRTF

**Possible Motion #1:** Recognizing the inherent recreational and community use value of the Karnes property for sale on the harbor contiguous to the existing Gillespie Beach Parking Lot, and, contiguous to the St James Township Governmental Center; further recognizing the urgency of pursuing the purchase to avoid private development, the township board hereby authorizes Kathleen McNamara to act on its behalf to form a core group to pursue an out-of-cycle process with the MNRTF for acquisition of Karnes Harbor Lots 52 & 53.

**Possible Motion #2:** Recognizing that if the acquisition process is approved by the MNRTF, a 25% local match will be required amounting to approximately \$240,000; the board commits to arranging for a closed-

bid sale of 'Old DNR Property Harborside Parcel', the entirety of the proceeds to go towards this grant; further the board agrees to a commitment of up to \$50,000 from the existing special projects fund(ATT).
