Ordinance No. 3 of 2020

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ST. JAMES
TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION ORDINANCE

THE TOWNSHIP OF ST. JAMES ORDAINS:

Section 1. Amendment of Section 2(a).

Section 2(a) of the St. James Township Planning Commission Ordinance, being Ordinance No. _____ of 2011, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

- (a). The township planning commission shall consist of seven (7) members. One (1) member shall be a member of the township board as an *ex officio* member with full voting rights on the planning commission. An employee of the township, however, shall not be eligible to be a member of the township planning commission. Members of the township planning commission shall be qualified electors of the township, except one (1) member may be an individual who is not a qualified elector of the township, but are qualified electors of another local unit of government. In addition, members of the township planning commission shall be representative of the entire territory of the township to the extent practicable and shall be representative of important segments of the township, such as the economic, governmental, educational, and social development of the township, in accordance with the major interests as they exist in the township, such as agricultural, natural resources, recreation, education, public health, government, transportation, industry, and commerce.

Section 2. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective the day following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation within the township.
