

SURREY TOWNSHIP BOARD

MEETING RULES

- SILENCE ALL PHONES
- THE PUBLIC HAS A RIGHT TO ATTEND AND WATCH THE BOARD DO ITS BUSINESS
- THE PUBLIC DOES NOT HAVE A RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE DELIBERATIONS OR DECISION OF A TOWNSHIP BOARD
- DISRUPTION OF A MEETING WILL GET A WARNING, A SECOND DISRUPTION WILL WARRANT AN EJECTION FROM THE MEETING
- THE PUBLIC COMMENT SECTION OF THE AGENDA IS A PLACE SET ASIDE FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ONLY AND IS LIMITED TO (2) MINUTES PER PERSON
- PUBLIC COMMENT IS NOT A TIME FOR THE BOARD MEMBERS TO COMMENT AND HAVE DISCUSSION
- **FIRST** LISTED PUBLIC COMMENT IS IN REGARDS TO AGENDA ITEMS ONLY
- **SECOND** LISTED PUBLIC COMMENT IS FOR ANY OTHER BUSINESS
- LARGE GROUPS REPRESENTING A PARTICULAR POSITION SHOULD APPOINT A SPOKESPERSON TO PRESENT THE GROUP'S POSITION
- A GROUP MIGHT CONSIDER BEING PUT ON A FUTURE AGENDA FOR MORE AVAILABLE DISCUSSION
- A "POINT OF ORDER" CAN BE RAISED AT ANY TIME WHEN ANY MEMBER NOTICES A VIOLATION OF THE RULES. THIS DOES NOT APPLY TO MEMBERS OF THE AUDIENCE.
