Notice is hereby given that on August 14, 2023, the Town Council (the "Council") of the Town of Tappahannock, Virginia (the "Town") will conduct a public hearing, which may be continued or adjourned, as required under applicable law, in accordance with Section 15.2-1813 of the Code of Virginia of 1950, the purpose:

**A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE DISPOSITION OF INTERESTS IN REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE TOWN OF TAPPAHANNOCK, VIRGINIA, SUCH PROPERTY BEING LOCATED AT 1140 AND 1154 TAPPAHANNOCK BLVD AND FURTHER KNOWN AS TAX MAP PARCEL NOS. 37C-3-1 AND 37C-3-2. THE INTERESTS IN REAL PROPERTY BEING THOSE IMPACTED BY THE DECLARATION OF OPEN SPACE SUCH THAT THE LAND, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN TERMS AND CONDITIONS, BE USED IN PERPETUITY FOR THE PRESERVATION AND PROVISION OF OPEN-SPACE LAND FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES, CONSERVATION OF ECOLOGICAL RESOURCES AND NATURAL AREAS, AND TO FURTHER OPEN SPACE VALUES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE OPEN-SPACE LAND ACT §§ 10.1-1700 THROUGH 10.1-1705 OF THE CODE OF VIRGINIA (1950), AS AMENDED.**

The public hearing, which may be continued or adjourned, will be conducted at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, by the Council in the Tappahannock Town Council Chambers, Tappahannock Municipal Building, 915 Church Lane, Tappahannock, Virginia. Interested persons may appear at such time and place and present their views whether orally or in writing or submit written comments prior to the hearing. The Council may set time limits on speakers and other rules and procedures for the conduct of this public hearing.
