being presents, the following resolution was adopted:

A RESOLUTION accepting for and on behalf of the Town of Buffalo, Texas, the provisions of Title 28, R. S. 1925, and amendments thereto, relating to cities and towns.

It was moved by Alderman Tom Cochran, and seconded by Alderman E. L. Sheffield, that the resolution be adopted, and the motion carried by the following vote:

There being more than two-thirds vote of the Board in favor of the resolution, the same was declared adopted.

The resolution follows:

A RESOLUTION accepting for and on behalf of the Town of Buffalo, Texas, the provisions of Title 28, Revised Statutes of Texas, 1925, and amendments thereto, relating to cities and towns.

WHEREAS, Article 961, Revised Statutes of Texas, 1925, provides:

"Any incorporated city, town or village in this State containing six hundred inhabitants or over, however legally incorporated, and any incorporated city, town or village of whatever populations containing one or more manufacturing establishments within the corporate limits, may accept the provisions of this title relating to cities and towns, in lieu of any existing charter, by two-thirds vote of the council of such city, town or village, had at a regular meeting thereof, and entered upon the journal of their proceedings, and a copy of the same signed by the mayor and attested by the Clerk or secretary under the corporate seal, filed and recorded in the office of the county clerk in which such city, town or village is situated, and the provisions of this title shall be in force, and all acts theretofore passed incorporating said city, town or village which may be in force by virtue of any existing charter, shall be repealed from and after the filing of said copy of their proceedings, as aforesaid. When such city, town or village is so incorporated as herein provided, the same shall be known as a city or town, subject to the provisions of this title relating to cities and towns, and vested with all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities and franchises therein conferred. The provisions of this title shall not apply to any city, town or village until such provisions have been accepted by the council in accordance with this article."

AND WHEREAS, The Town of Buffalo, in the County of Leon, Texas, was on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 19\_\_\_\_, duly incorporated as a town or village in conformity with the provisions and requirements of Chapter 11, Title 28, Revised Statutes, 1925, as shown by the order of the County Judge of said County declaring the result of the election therefor, and which order is of record in Book \_\_\_\_\_ page \_\_\_\_\_, Deed Records of Leon County, Texas, and also in Vol. \_\_\_\_\_ page \_\_\_\_\_, of the Minutes of the Commissioners Court of said County; and

WHEREAS, it now appears from an official census of said Town of Buffalo, Texas, that the same has more than six hundred actual bona fide inhabitants;

AND WHEREAS, the Board of Alderman of said Town now deems it advisable for said Town to accept the provisions of Title 28, Revised Statutes of Texas, 1925, and amendments

thereto, relating to cities and towns, and thereby become vested with all the rights, powers and privileges conferred upon cities and towns incorporated under the general laws;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF BUFFALO, TEXAS.

Section 1. That the town of Buffalo, Texas, hereby accepts as its organic law all the provisions of Title 28, Revised Statutes of Texas, 1925, and amendments thereto, relating to cities and towns.

Section 2. That the said Town shall be hereafter known as a city or town and subject to all the provisions of said Title 28, Revised Statutes of Texas, 1925, relating to cities and towns incorporated under the general laws, and shall be vested with all the rights, powers, privileges, immunities and franchises therein conferred.

Section 3. That this resolution shall be entered upon the Official Minutes of the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Buffalo, Texas, and a copy thereof, signed by the Mayor and attested by the Town Secretary under the corporate seal, shall be filed and recorded in the office of the Clerk of the County Court of Leon County, Texas.
