

Whereas on the 15th, day of December, A.D. 1912, a petition was presented to L. J. Dashiell, County Judge of Leon County, Texas, asking that an election be ordered to determine whether or not the town of Buffalo, in Leon County, Texas should be incorporated, under Chapter Fourteen of the Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, (1911);

And whereas, satisfactory proof was made that the territory sought to be incorporated contained the requisite number of inhabitants and that more than twenty qualified voters residing within such territory had affixed their names to said petition, praying for an election to determine whether or not the town of Buffalo should be incorporated as aforesaid, - the boundaries of said proposed town being described as follows:

Beginning S. W. Cor of D. A. Lowrance Sur a Stake, thence a bearing S. 40 W. 4-5/10, B of N. 19 E. Thence S. 30 W. 752 vrs. with N. W. line of S. White survey a stake, S. E. Cor. of R. White 80 acre survey Thence N. 60 W. 600 vrs to his N. W. Cor. in S. line of Keen 160 Sur a Stake. Thence S. 30 W. at 198 vrs. pass N. Keen's S. W. Cor at 432 vrs. a Stake for corner in the N. Part of P. L. Keen's Sur. Thence N 60 W. at 40 vrs pass J. H. Joyce tenant house on his Keen farm at 208 vrs. R. R. right of way at 1158 vrs N. W. Cor of L. R. Moody's 160 acre Survey Thence N 30 E. at 205 pass J. P. Parker's N Cor at 1065 pass R. Clark's N. Cor in W line of Mary Walker 160 acre survey, at 1465 pass Cedar road at 2025 pass Mrs Walker's line 56 vrs N 60 W of I & G. N. R. R. Co's N. W. Cor at 2585 vrs cross Luna Road 56 vrs N 60 W. P. L. Williams N. W. Cor at 2975 pass Mrs Walker's line at 3549 a stake N. 60 W. 56 vrs. from P. L. Williams N. Cor Thence S. 60 E.

with said P. L. Williams N.E. line at 500 vrs pass

vey at 894 vrs N.E. Cor of Mary Gray sur Thence S.  
15 E at 950 vrs pass her S.E. Cor at 1,240 vrs N.E. Cor  
of Paul Hay 80 acre sur Thence N. 60 W. with the  
N. line of said Hay sur. at 840 vrs a stake and  
N.W. Cor of J. S. Lorraine's 36 acre tract in said  
sur Thence S. 30 W. 475 vrs. with Lorraine's line  
a stake in the N. line of S. White's 160 acre sur  
and the Centerville road Thence N 60 W. 120 vrs.  
with the road to S.E. Cor of D. A. Lorraine's sur  
and the N.W. Cor of S. White's sur. Thence S. 30 W.  
308 vrs. with White's and Lorraine's line to place  
of beginning"

And whereas, in response to the  
aforesaid petition and in conformity with law  
an election was ordered to be held in the town  
of Buffalo, Leon County Texas on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of  
February, A.D. 1913. to determine whether or not the  
inhabitants of the town, within the boundaries  
above described, should be incorporated; And  
whereas, said election was held in conformity  
with law on said date and the returns thereof  
were forwarded to the County Judge of Leon  
County, Texas and upon being canvassed,  
said returns showed that 55 votes were  
cast for Incorporation, and 24 votes were cast  
for no Incorporation;

Therefore, it is known, that the  
inhabitants of the town of Buffalo, within  
the above described boundaries, are incor-  
porated (from the date hereof) in  
accordance with Chapter Fourteen of The  
Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, (1911).
