

Public Works Maintenance Worker Opening(s).

Primary Duties: Performs physical labor in all Weather Conditions, Use of Hand tools, Operation of pickup trucks, dump trucks, skid loader, backhoe/loader, mowers, chainsaws, trimmers, generators, sewer jetter and asphalt roller, Plowing and Salting of City streets, alleys, parking lots and sidewalks. Assists and performs activities in the construction, repair, maintenance and operation of City infrastructure. Uses and maintains various hand tools and equipment. Practices accepted safety and preventative maintenance procedures at all times. Assists others in the performance of their public works duties. Other duties as assigned by the Superintendent of Public Works, Maintenance Foreman and Senior Maintenance Workers. Willingness and Ability to Work Overtime, Attendance during Afterhours/Late Night/Holiday/Weekend Calls for Service as Needed and Requested.

Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities: Knowledge and an understanding of the basic operation of equipment and use of hand tools along with Routine Maintenance of Equipment and Tools. Observe accepted safety and preventative maintenance procedures at all times. Knowledge, understanding, and ability to follow policies and practices of the Public Works Department. Must be able to work in all weather conditions and be physically able perform the basic job duties required in Public Works (i.e., Lifting, Digging, Shoveling). Ability to deal tactfully with the public and other employees. Mechanical Aptitude, Applicant Must either Currently Hold or Obtain a valid Illinois Class A or B commercial driver license (CDL) within 6 months of hire and retain throughout Employment. Experience operating Equipment preferred but not required.

Minimum Qualifications: High School Diploma, GED or equivalent work experience. Ability to speak, write and understand the English language. Must have a valid Illinois Driver License.
