We must amend our latest work on “mother-in-law” housing to eliminate our cap on number of total requests per year of 5 to unlimited, our limit on parking to unlimited and from no new structures allowed to allowing new building as these things are in the new state law and take precedence

Further discussion on other changes to make and on allowance of multiple house lots and the fact that this new rule doesn't override our shoreline rules
