**AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE SALARY OF THE MAYOR AND ALDERPERSONS OF THE CITY OF TIPTON, MISSOURI AND TO ESTABLISH THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Alderpersons of the City of Tipton, Missouri as follows:

- Section 1.** From and after April 3, 2024 the salary of the Mayor of the City of Tipton, Missouri shall be the sum of \$8,000 per year, payable monthly
- Section 2.** From and after April 3, 2024 the salary of the Alderpersons of the City of Tipton, Missouri shall be the sum of \$2,400 per year, payable monthly.
- Section 3.** The Mayor and Alderpersons elected to office prior to the election held April 2, 2024 shall receive the annual salary in effect when they were elected to their respective offices.
- Section 4.** This ordinance repeals all ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict herewith.
- Section 5.** This ordinance shall be in effect from and after the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April 2024.

**AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A SALES TAX AT A RATE OF THREE PERCENT ON ALL TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY RETAIL SALES OF ADULT USE MARIJUANA SOLD WITHIN THE CITY OF TIPTON, MISSOURI, PURSUANT TO ARTICLE XIV, SECTION 2.6(5) OF THE MISSOURI CONSTITUTION SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL BY THE VOTERS OF THE CITY AT THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON APRIL 2, 2024; DESIGNATING THE FORM OF BALLOT; AND DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO PROVIDE NOTICE OF SAID ELECTION.**

**WHEREAS**, on November 8, 2022, the electors of the State of Missouri approved Amendment 3 to the Missouri Constitution enacting Section 2 of Article XIV of the Missouri Constitution effective December 8, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the newly enacted Article XIV, section 2.6(5) of the Missouri Constitution authorizes the City of Tipton, Missouri to impose, by ordinance, an additional sales tax in amount not to exceed three percent on all tangible personal property retail sales of adult use marijuana sold in such political subdivision subject to approval by voters of the City of Tipton, Missouri; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Alderpersons finds that it is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Tipton, Missouri to impose a sales tax of three percent on all tangible personal property retail sales of adult use marijuana sold in the City of Tipton, Missouri and to submit the same to the voters of the City for approval by a majority of those voting at the general municipal election to be held on April 2, 2024.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Alderpersons of Tipton, Missouri as follows:

**Section 1.** A sales tax at the rate of three percent on all tangible personal property retail sales of adult use marijuana sold in the City of Tipton, Missouri, as authorized by Article XIV, section 2.6(5) of the Missouri Constitution, is hereby imposed. The tax imposed hereunder shall be in addition to any and all other sales taxes allowed by law.

**Section 2.** The sales tax imposed by this Ordinance shall not be effective unless approved by a majority of the votes cast by the qualified voters voting thereon at the General Municipal Election to be held on April 2, 2024, at which election a proposal to authorize the Board of Alderpersons of the City of Tipton, Missouri, to impose the tax herein provided for shall be submitted to the voters of the City of Tipton.

**Section 3.** The ballot to be used in such election shall contain the following question:

**Question 1**

Shall the City of Tipton Missouri, impose a sales tax of three percent (3%) on all retail sales of adult use marijuana sold in the City of Tipton, Missouri?

**Section 4.** The City Clerk is hereby directed to notify the Clerk of Moniteau County, Missouri, of the enactment of this Ordinance no later than 5:00 pm. on Tuesday, January 23, 2024, in accordance with the Comprehensive Election Act, Chapter 115 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended.

**Section 5.** Within ten (10) days after the approval of this ordinance by the qualified voters of Tipton, Missouri, the City Clerk shall forward to the Director of Revenue of the State of Missouri by United States registered mail or certified mail, a certified copy of this ordinance together with certifications of the election returns and accompanied by a map of the City clearly showing the boundaries thereof.

**Section 6.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
