

Selectmen's Meeting  
Minutes  
Town Office, April 2, 2024 @ 3:00 pm

Meeting called to order at 3:06 pm, present – David Reiley, Stacia Nevin

1. Minutes of March 19 were approved on March 21, 2024.
2. Public Works: Registered Public Works crew for a Spring Roads Workshop on May 8 in Brewer. Progress occurring on road improvements at Bridges Point access. Prepping road for pavement. Washouts in ditches on other town roads. Washouts in ditches being addressed as a result of storm damage.
3. School Renovation Project: All referendum warrant posted by the legal deadline. Moving forward on schedule.
4. Hale's Hill Project: Superior Concrete culvert design submitted to Town Engineer for approval.
5. Harbor Management Committee- Select Board contacted an abutting landowner on Gaffney Lane to discuss possible future plans for access. Select Board received a letter of support from a resident outlining the historic use of Dodge's Wharf landing and Dodge's Wharf Road. Select Board working to establish a documented history of the use of the easement/right of way/ or ownership of the access road.
6. Other: Community Action Grant application has been submitted and received. We should hear back by mid May. -- Town has received an inquiry from the abutters concerning the maintenance of right of way at the Town Recreation Park. Inquiry under investigation by Maine Municipal Association Legal Services.—Town Attorney recommends present board opts to accept existing agreement of property dispute issues at the parking area on Harriman Point Road. Attorney advises that no town vote is necessary, this is simply the final step in the process that began years ago.
