Meeting called to order at 3:00 pm, present – David Reiley, Nick Carter, Stacia Eaton and Tammy Andrews

1. Minutes of May 14 were approved on May 16, 2024.
2. Public Works: Board approved – Storage container moved from High St. to garage site; new sickle mower purchased and has been in use; town was awarded from Maine Municipal Workers Compensation fund a safety grant in the amount of 2,927 for safety equipment; Asplundh completed some more tree trimming on Naskeag Road, will return in the next fiscal year.
3. School Renovation Project - May 16th referendum vote was defeated 159 to 137.
4. Hale's Hill Project – Nothing new to report.
5. Town Landings - Floating dock at Naskeag installation is complete; board will try to find someone to do some painting.
6. Legal Issues – Board met with town attorney about notice of appeal regarding property on Rob Road, denied by Appeals Board last year, hearing to be set up with Appeals Board.
7. Appeals Board Resignation – Todd Richardson resigned from board effective immediately.
8. Other: Board met with Brian Archer from the Hancock County Sheriff's Office last week regarding patrols and July 3rd; made arrangements for rollaway from BHD Containers and Mt. Desert Port-O-Potties for July 3rd and 4th; Town Office sign to be replaced, received quote from Reed Hayden; signed up for digital subscription to Bangor Daily News; Reiley attended last Thursday a meeting with the Commission on Infrastructure Rebuilding and Resilience with Janet Mills in Stonington.
