

Selectmen's Meeting
Minutes
Town Office, July 23, 2024 @ 3:00 pm

Meeting called to order at 3:05 pm, present – David Reiley, Nick Carter and Tammy Andrews

1. Minutes of July 9 were approved on July 11, 2024.
2. Public Works: Asplundh continues work cutting back the sides of town roads presently on Harriman Point Road; washout from this morning's rainstorm repaired on Flye Point Road where new culvert had been installed and awaiting paving; road commissioner to install signs at Bridge's Point clarifying public vs. private access at landing.
3. Town Landings – Handrail ready to be installed at Naskeag.
4. Hales Hill Project – Eaton Paving in second week for prep work for new culvert and widening of road next month; abutter's concerns addressed on road closures; questions regarding legibility of warning signs regarding closures.
5. Copier Lease Contract Action Item – Signed lease for new copier with Xerox.
6. Other: Visit from Loss Control Consultant from Maine Municipal Association Risk Management Services to follow up from 2023 safety assessment of town buildings, about 50% of concerns raised last year have been addressed; Also visited Naskeag to see new floating dock to add to policy. Tax bills have been printed and will be mailed out soon; Resilience Committee researching possible sites for electric car recharging station.
