

Selectmen's Meeting  
Minutes  
Town Office, July 25, 2023 @ 3:00 pm

Meeting called to order at 3:00 pm, present – David Reiley, Stacia Nevin, Tammy Andrews, resident Susan Snider

1. Minutes of July 11, 2023 were approved on July 13, 2023.
2. Reassignment of Selectboard – Motion was made by Nevin to appoint Reiley First Selectman, motion passed unanimously.
3. Community Resilience Partnership Committee update – Committee holding forum at the Brooklin School on August 10<sup>th</sup> with a presentation from Downeast Community Partners regarding county based options.
4. Community Action grant update – No further updates to report.
5. Public works - Message regarding tree trimming to be posted on website and facebook; treasurer to inquire Bar Harbor Bank regarding financing of a tractor, only municipal leases can be obtained through dealership; Resident Snider inquired about a paving schedule, reported Back Road is deteriorating, Reiley to confer with Road Commissioner.
6. Insurance Risk Report – No completion deadline for repairs required has been set; propane detector has been ordered; fire chief to look into replacement batteries for emergency lights; selectboard will complete items that they can do themselves.
7. Legal – Town attorney advised board that Allen will remove obstacles from disputed land in the next month and advised Allen that no right of first refusal on land can be given.
8. Library: Letter from board, parking – Selectboard received letter from library trustees that in consideration of vacant board seat it won't be necessary until seat is filled. No parking signs removed from posts in front of library; rope fence to be strung between them, rope on order from Hamilton Marine.
9. Motor Vehicle Agent Policies – Board unanimously adopted policies required by the State.
10. Other – Snider inquired about rapid renewal of registrations online, board will put on next agenda and discuss with Clerk; Snider inquired about vacant board seat, no decision as of this date; awarded \$50,000 grant for shore and harbor planning to be used for Bridge's Point and Dodge's Wharf; Doug Hylan came in to advocate for heat pumps for town office, informed him no funds available in this year's budget (already voted on in April).
