Minutes
Town Office, September 19, 2023 @ 3:00 pm

Meeting called to order at 3:00 pm, present – David Reiley, Stacia Nevin, Heather Candage, Town Clerk and Tammy Andrews

1. Minutes of September 5, 2023 were approved on September 7, 2023.
2. Public works – Sides of some roads need repair from Saturday's storm. Paving complete on Bridge's Point Road and on Flye Point from Lookout to blueberry field (approximately one mile).
3. Community Resilience Partnership – new fellow has begun work; board told by Allen Kratz that town did not received Community Action Grant this round to help funding for fellow, he will apply again in January.
4. Town Office RFP – A few responses from out of state contractors and one local.
5. School Renovation Project – Informational Meeting with public being planned. (Notice received September 21 that meeting will take place on Wednesday, September 27 at the school library from 6-7 pm). Discussion with clerk regarding referendum or vote on project. No decision on process has been made as of this date.
6. General Assistance standards – Board voted unanimously to adopt state standards.
7. Ordinance for Appeals Board – Pending from town attorney.
8. Revise Site Plan Review Ordinance – Pending from town attorney.
9. YMCA meeting – Nevin reported on zoom meeting with contributing towns and citizens with YMCA representatives.
10. Tree Clearing in Town – Asplundh work complete for this year. Out of state company working in area for Versant.
11. Other – David Zachow of Brooksville asked board for affordable housing update. Nothing to report as of this date.
