

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order at 3:00 pm, present- William Cohen, David Reiley, Stacia Nevin

1. Minutes of September 6, 2022 were approved on September 8, 2022
2. Comp Plan update- committee now meeting 2 times a month and still looking for an editor to read over and proofread the comp plan.
3. Community Wildfire Defense Grant- Application deadline is Oct. 7, this is a matching grant with a potential cost of \$1333 for Brooklin. This is a grant that would be shared among the 9 Peninsula towns. Moved to sign a Resolution to Support a Joint Application for a Community Wildfire Defense Grant.
4. Public Works update- the new dump truck will be ready for use next week. Roadside clearing and chipping continue on Naskeag and Flye Point.
5. Plow Contract- meeting on Thursday 9-22 at 3:30
6. Adoption of GA guidelines- voted to adopt General Assistance guideline provided by the State of Maine for 2022-2023
7. Fire Dept 75th update- a banner will be displayed on the town office front lawn. The 75th anniversary celebration is on October 15, 4-6 pm.
8. Shellfish update: We have formally requested from the State of Maine DMR that a rainfall study be conducted.
9. Other-Brooklin is applying in the second round of the 2022 Municipal Stream Crossing Infrastructure Grants for the Hale's Hill culvert. November 20 deadline. Working with Allen Kratz on the application. On Thursday September 22 one representative from 8 Peninsula towns, developers, and code enforcement will be meeting at the Brooklin School to talk about the Peninsula housing shortage. Allen Kratz will moderate.
