

Selectmen's Meeting
Minutes
Town Office, April 5, 2022 @ 3:00 pm

Meeting called to order at 3:08 pm, present – William Cohen, Stacia Nevin, David Reiley and Tammy Andrews

1. Minutes of March 22, 2022 were approved on March 24, 2022
2. Organizational meeting – Cohen elected chair of selectboard by Reiley and Nevin. Selectboard Representatives, Nevin (School board and GSA), Reiley (Planning Board, MDOT and GA), Cohen (Finance, Shellfish and Library) all on Comprehensive Plan update.
3. Appointments – Board made following appointments: CarolAnn Cutler-Animal Control; Judy Jenkins-CEO, Plumbing Inspector and Health Officer; Sam Friend – Clam Warden and Constable; Travis Reiley-Planning Board; Todd Richardson-Appeals Board; Peter Gray (alt.), Sidney Balch and Mike Thalhauser-Shellfish Committee; Tammy Andrews-Administrative Assistant, Deputy Clerk and Deputy Tax Collector.
4. Annual meeting update – Board to develop plan for old town office. Nevin insisted building inspection be done. Selectboard thanks Candage and Andrews for their work on preparing for and conducting the annual meeting.
5. Trash talk update; Amendment – Board notified Blue Hill/Surry that town voted to accept amendment at annual meeting.
6. RBAC update; NTIA event – Peninsula wide meeting held 4/4; Consult with Consolidated for time line for project of private drop construction.
7. Naskeag; property owner concerns; next steps – Board received email from abutting property owner, board to inform Andrew McCullough funds available July 1 to continue project.
8. Center Harbor; M.E. Astbury; DEP – Notified Astbury funds will be available July 1 to continue work; DEP advised board that permit by rule issued last year is still valid.
9. Web site – Funds approved for web site update; board will begin search for designer.
10. Maine Lobstermen's Association request – Board received request for help in funding lawsuit against Federal Government, board voted to not do so at this time.
11. Hales Hill – Andrew McCullough working on new federal grant request for improvements.
12. Regional Meeting – Peninsula selectboards to meet at Blue Hill Town Office, April 13 at 9 am.
13. Other – Board's attempt for contacting individual regarding Pervear property unanswered; will try to contact Mrs. Murfey directly. Reiley contacted regarding little league baseball support, board voted to give \$250 from recreation fund.
