

WINTER ROAD MAINTENANCE CONTRACT

TOWN OF NEWFIELD, MAINE

This AGREEMENT, made this	day of	, 20 , is between
the INHABITANTS OF THE TOWN OF NEWFIE	LD, County of York and State	e of Maine, (hereinafter
referred to as "the TOWN ") and

(hereinafter referred to as "the CONTRACTO	R").	

WITNESSETH

For mutual considerations hereinafter set forth, the **CONTRACTOR** hereby agrees to scrape and/or remove snow from, and apply salt and sand to, the roads and ways in **TOWN** as hereinafter provided. The **TOWN** agrees to pay the **CONTRACTOR** for such services, as hereinafter provided.

A. **SNOWPLOWING**

- 1. The CONTRACTOR shall, upon the request of the TOWN's Road Commissioner and/or Select Board, scrape or remove snow, sleet, or slush (hereinafter collectively referred to as "snow") from all public roads and ways and treat all public roads and ways in the TOWN at any time the Road Commissioner and/or Select Board considers such roads to be hazardous or dangerous. In addition, when needed for response in emergency situations, such snow removal services may be requested by public safety officials. The CONTRACTOR shall continue such operation until all such roads and ways have been cleared of snow to the outside shoulders. The roads and ways covered by this Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "subject roads and ways") are those listed in Exhibit A.1 to this Agreement.
- 2. The **CONTRACTOR** shall, on its own initiative and without the request of the Road Commissioner and/or Select Board, scrape, treat, or remove all snow from all subject roads and ways at any time when snow has accumulated to a depth of two (2) inches

on any of the subject roads and ways in the **TOWN**, either from actual snow fall, drifting, freezing rain, and/or slush or at the end of a snow event of less than two (2) inches, and shall continue such operations until all subject roads and ways have been cleared of snow to the outside shoulders. During periods of continuing accumulation, the **CONTRACTOR** shall plow, scrape or treat all subject roads and ways at least once every four (4) hours.

3. Snow shall be scraped or removed from the entire paved width of all subject roads and ways in such a manner as complies with Maine Department of Transportation's regulations and standards and in such a manner as will not to create a hazard to traffic safety and the public welfare. The CONTRACTOR will perform the services provided for herein to the satisfaction of the TOWN, who shall have the right of inspection at all times and whose approval and acceptance of the said services shall be a condition precedent to payments from the TOWN under this Agreement. In the event of any dispute as to the amounts, nature, or scope of the services required under this Agreement, the decision and judgment of the TOWN shall be final and binding.

B. **SANDING**

4. The **CONTRACTOR** shall, upon request of the Road Commissioner and/or Select Board, apply sand and salt mixture to the entire travel surface of all subject roads and ways at any time the Road Commissioner and/or Select Board considers the roads to be hazardous and dangerous. The **CONTRACTOR** shall, on it's own initiative and without the request of the Road Commissioner and/or Select Board, apply salt and sand mixture to the entire travel surface of all subject roads and ways within 30 minutes after any such road or way has been plowed.

The **CONTRACTOR** agrees to pay particular attention to the sanding of hills, curves, and intersections, and to apply extra sand to such locations when necessary.

- 5. The salt and sand mixture shall be provided by the **TOWN**. The **CONTRACTOR** shall be responsible for the storage, and loading, of the sand and salt per State requirements or it shall be stored at the **TOWN'S** salt and sand facility at such time when said facility is completed. The **CONTRACTOR** is responsible for providing loading equipment and labor for loading sand and salt.
- 6. The salt and sand mixture shall be applied to the subject roads and ways in such manner as complies with Maine Department of Transportation's regulations and

standards and in such a manner as will not create a hazard to traffic safety and the public welfare. The recommendation of the Maine Department of Transportation regarding proper methods and standards of salt and sand application shall be determinative.

C. PRIORITIES

- 7. The **TOWN's** Road Commissioner and Select Board will set the order of priorities for the maintenance of the subject roads and ways. Attached hereto as *Exhibit B.1* is an outline of the Town's order of priorities in this regard. Said priorities shall be followed by the **CONTRACTOR**. The **CONTRACTOR** shall perform all required duties for the TOWN before proceeding to work on private contracts.
- 8. In case of an emergency, the **CONTRACTOR** also agrees to attempt to plow and/or sand any roads and ways that are not subject to this Agreement. A request for emergency plowing or sanding may be made by the Town's Road Commissioner, Fire Chief, Rescue Squad Chief, State Police, or Sheriff's Department, RSU#57 Transportation and the Select Board.

D. <u>INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR</u>

- 9. The CONTRACTOR, during the performance of this Agreement, shall act in an independent capacity and not as an officer or employee or agent of the TOWN. Any manpower needed to fulfill the obligations of this Agreement shall be employed by and paid by the CONTRACTOR.
- 10. The CONTRACTOR shall be solely responsible for complying with applicable state and federal laws including but not limited to worker's compensation laws, employment security laws, and minimum wage laws. The CONTRACTOR shall, on or before October 1st of each year of this Agreement, provide to the TOWN proof of worker's compensation coverage for its employees or provide a Letter of Predetermination from Maine Worker's Compensation Board.
- 11. The **CONTRACTOR** must have supervisory personnel and radio equipped vehicles situated so that messages of urgency can reach plowing or sanding vehicles within a half-hour period. Additionally. The **CONTRACTOR** shall provide, in addition to radio equipment for each vehicle, proper cellular telephone and/or pager service.

- 12. The CONTRACTOR has the right and duty to supervise and control its own employees, agents, and equipment. The TOWN's Road Commissioner and/or Select Board have the right to inspect the CONTRACTOR's road maintenance operations, and notify the CONTRACTOR of any problems, errors or nonperformance. The Road Commissioner and/or Select Board may order that work be done in a satisfactory manner, to be determined by them.
- 13. The **CONTRACTOR** shall be responsible for any negligent damage to **TOWN** property by reason of snow removal operations under this Agreement if the **TOWN** officials determine that such damage could have been avoided.

E. EQUIPMENT AND MAINTENANCE

- 14. The **CONTRACTOR** shall acquire and/or maintain snow removal equipment consisting of at least the following:
 - (1) ¾ or 1 ton plow truck with sander
 - (1) 4-wheel drive plow and wing truck (40,000 GVW)
 - (3) Minimum- plow trucks with wing (32,000 GVW)
 - (1) Bucket Loader
 - (3) Minimum 8-yard sanders

The **CONTRACTOR** shall provide crews, sufficient and adequate to operate all equipment and service the subject roads and ways as required herein within a reasonable time.

- 15. Mechanical breakdowns or inability to provide adequate equipment or labor for proper snow removal and/or sanding shall not excuse the **CONTRACTOR** from performing its contractual duties.
- 16. All equipment provided by the **CONTRACTOR** shall remain the property of the **CONTRACTOR**. The **CONTRACTOR** shall be solely responsible for the maintenance and upkeep.
- 17. The **CONTRACTOR** shall, on or before October 1st of each year of this Agreement, provide the **TOWN** with proof of registration, inspection, and insurance of all equipment required by this Agreement and any and all other vehicles to be utilized by

the **CONTRACTOR** in performing its obligations hereunder. Said vehicles and equipment must be registered and insured as Commercial Vehicles.

- 18. The **TOWN** shall not be liable for any damage to or destruction of the **CONTRACTOR**'s equipment while engaged in the performance of its obligations hereunder.
- 19. **CONTRACTOR** must have all equipment required by this Agreement in hand by June 15, 2021.

F. PAYMENT *

20.	The '	TOWN	agrees	to p	pay to	CONTRA	ACTOR	the:	sum	of:

- d. \$_____ per mile for 2028-2029 (if Agreement is extended)

for proper removal of said snow and proper application of sand/salt mixture to the approximately thirty-six point four five (36.45) miles of subject roads and ways in said **TOWN**. The **CONTRACTOR** shall ensure that all subject roads and ways are safe and accessible for the public welfare. Except for the cost of salt and sand, the **CONTRACTOR** shall be responsible for all costs (including labor, equipment, materials) necessary to perform its obligations under this Agreement.

*This Agreement is for three (3) years with a fourth (4th) year option at the discretion of the Road Commissioner and Select Board with the consent of the **CONTRACTOR**. The **CONTRACTOR'S** obligations under this Agreement shall commence September 1st and end May 31st during each year of this Agreement.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement, the parties agree and understand that the Agreement price is payable from appropriation made by Town Meeting each year. In the event the Town Meeting fails to appropriate a sufficient amount to fund this Agreement for a contracted year, this Agreement may be terminated by the Select Board without further obligation of the **TOWN**. In such an event, the Select Board shall certify to the **CONTRACTOR** that sufficient funds have not been appropriated to meet the obligations of the Agreement. Such certification shall be conclusive upon both parties.

- 21. In the event that a **TOWN** road or way is deleted or added to the list of subject roads and ways, the **TOWN** reserves the right to adjust the monetary payments to the **CONTRACTOR** according to the per mile cost agreed upon.
- 22. It is agreed that payment to the **CONTRACTOR** shall be as follows:

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Fourteen percent (14%) October 1<sup>st</sup>
Fourteen percent (14%) November 1<sup>st</sup>
Fourteen percent (14%) December 1<sup>st</sup>
Fourteen percent (14%) January 1<sup>st</sup>
Fourteen percent (14%) February 1<sup>st</sup>
Fourteen percent (14%) March 1<sup>st</sup>
Sixteen percent (16%) April 15<sup>th</sup> (security payment)
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Of each year during the term of this Agreement; satisfactory performance by the **CONTRACTOR** may result in earlier payment of the security balance (April 15th payment).

G. ASSIGNMENT/SUBCONTRACTING

23. **CONTRACTOR** shall not sub-contract, sell, assign, or in any way transfer this Agreement to any other person, entity, or corporation without the express written consent of the **TOWN's** Select Board. If the Select Board consents to any such sub-contract, sale, assignment, or transfer, the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall be binding on all successors and assigns of the parties hereto.

H. INDEMNIFICATION/INSURANCE/BONDING

24. The **CONTRACTOR** shall hold the **TOWN** and any of its officers, officials, employees, and agents (collectively referred to as the "**TOWN**"), in both their public and personal capacities, harmless from any claim for death, injury, property damage or other losses or expenses that may result from the **CONTRACTOR**'s performance of services under this Agreement. In the event that such a claim is made against the **TOWN**, the **CONTRACTOR** will defend the **TOWN** and bear the costs of such a defense. The **CONTRACTOR** will also indemnify the **TOWN** for any amount for which the **TOWN** may be held liable in a legal action for such claims.

The **CONTRACTOR** and its subcontractors shall obtain and maintain throughout the term of this Agreement at no expense to the **TOWN** the following insurance coverages through an insurance carrier licensed to do business in the State of Maine:

- a. **Commercial General Liability Insurance** in the amount of not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000), combined single limit, to protect the **CONTRACTOR**, any subcontractor performing work covered by this Agreement, and the **TOWN** from claims and damages that may arise from operations under this Agreement, whether such operations be by the **CONTRACTOR** or by any subcontractor or by anyone directly or indirectly employed by them.
- b. **Motor Vehicle Liability Insurance** in the amount of not less than Five-Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000), combined single limit, to protect the **CONTRACTOR**, any subcontractor performing work covered by this Agreement, and the **TOWN** from claims and damages that may arise from operations under this Agreement, whether such operations be by the **CONTRACTOR** or by a subcontractor or by anyone directly or indirectly employed by them.
- c. Workers' Compensation Insurance in amounts required by Maine law and Employer's Liability Insurance, as necessary, as required by Maine law. In case any class of employees engaged in hazardous work under this Agreement is not protected under the Workers' Compensation Act, the CONTRACTOR shall provide for the protection of its employees not otherwise protected.

All such insurance policies shall name the **TOWN** and its officers, agents, and employees, as additional insured, expect that for purposes of workers' compensation insurance, the **CONTRACTOR** and its subcontractors instead may provide a written waiver of subrogation rights against the **TOWN**. The **CONTRACTOR**, prior to commencement of any work under this Agreement, and any of its subcontractors, prior to commencement of work under any subcontract, shall deliver to the **TOWN** certificates satisfactory to the **TOWN** evidencing such insurance coverages, which certificates shall state that the **CONTRACTOR** and its subcontractors must provide written notice to the **TOWN** at least ten (10) days prior to the cancellation, non-renewal, material modification or expiration of any policies, evidenced by return receipt of United States Certified Mail. Replacement certificates shall be delivered to the **TOWN** prior to the effective date of cancellation, termination, material modification, or expiration of any such insurance policy. The **CONTRACTOR** shall not commence work under this Agreement until it has obtained all insurance coverages

required under this subparagraph and such insurance policies have been approved by the **TOWN**, nor shall the **CONTRACTOR** allow any of its subcontractors to commence work on any subcontract until all such insurance policies have been obtained by the subcontractor and approved by the **TOWN**. All such insurance policies shall have a retroactive date which is the earlier of the date of this Agreement or the **CONTRACTOR's** commencement of work thereunder.

The **CONTRACTOR** shall provide the **TOWN** with a list of any subcontractors who will perform services under this Agreement, along with proof of insurance (of types and in amounts as required for **CONTRACTOR** above) for each of them. The **CONTRACTOR** shall promptly notify the **TOWN** if any subcontractors are added during the term of this Agreement and shall provide with the notification proof of insurance for each subcontractor. It will be the responsibility of the **CONTRACTOR** and subcontractors to provide updated insurance certification as they expire or change.

I. BREACH OF CONTRACT

- 25. If the **CONTRACTOR** fails to perform according to the terms of this Agreement at the time and in the manner specified, that failure shall be a breach of contract. In the event of a breach, the **TOWN** (through its Road Commissioner and/or Select Board) shall immediately give oral notice, with a written follow-up notice, to the **CONTRACTOR**. The **CONTRACTOR** will then be required immediately to remedy the breach. In the event that the **CONTRACTOR** does not immediately remedy the breach, the TOWN may take any of the following action:
 - a. Terminate this Contract: The TOWN may terminate this Agreement by sending the CONTRACTOR written notice, stating the reason for termination. If the TOWN terminates the Agreement, it shall be relieved from any further obligation to make payments to the CONTRACTOR as otherwise contemplated by this Agreement and CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for any cost losses incurred by the TOWN as a result of the CONTRACTOR's breach.
 - b. Substitution: The **TOWN** may hire a substitute contractor to plow and sand the subject roads and ways for any period of time it considers necessary and may seek reimbursement from the **CONTRACTOR** for any additional expense it incurs in hiring a substitute **CONTRACTOR**.

The rights and remedies hereby created are cumulative and the use of one remedy shall not be taken to exclude or waive the right to use of another.

K. INTEGRATION, AMENDMENT, SEVERABILITY, JURISDICTION

- 27. This Agreement represents the entire agreement between the parties. No modification hereto shall be effective unless fully set forth in writing and executed by the parties hereto. If any provision of this Agreement is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be void or unenforceable, the rest of the Agreement shall continue to be valid and effect. This Agreement is made and shall be construed under the laws of the State of Maine without regard to conflict of law rules. The parties shall attempt to resolve any dispute arising from this Agreement first by informal negotiation and then by non-binding mediation. In the event that a dispute is not resolved through mediation, either party may pursue litigation. Except as otherwise expressly agreed by the parties in writing, exclusive venue for any civil action shall be in Maine Superior Court (York County).
- 28. This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be an original and together shall constitute one and the same instrument. The counterparts may be

executed and delivered by facsimile or other electronic signature (including portable document format) by either of the parties and the receiving party may rely on the receipt of such document so executed and delivered electronically or by facsimile as if the original had been received.
