Treasurer's Desk—Juli Hall

Read the following reminders confirming the information on your tax bill is correct.

- 1) Make sure you are receiving 100% Principal Residence Exemption located at the top right side of your bill marked **P.R.E. %: 100-** if you own & occupy your house.
- 2) Confirm your mailing address is correct— corrections can be made on the back of your tax bill when you return it with payment.
- 3) Confirm your mortgage company is correct. Advise lender/ township if changes need to be made. *Many mortgage companies use a tax service -(example: 1AMTX)*
- 4) **When making Payments remember:**

WE CANNOT ACCEPT CREDIT OR DEBIT CARDS

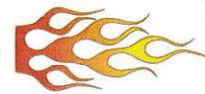
Payments need to be exact cash, check* or money order

****Please** review your check for: correct amount written matches numbers, signature & dated as these issues have risen which cause delays in payment status until rectified. If we do not have your correct contact information **-our only option is time-consuming snail-mail!****

5) Deferments & Disable Veterans Exemptions must be filed each year.

Tax payments can be mailed or placed in our 24-hr drop box to the east side of our building or in person during office hours. (office hours are shown on the front of this newsletter)
