## **Significant Calls of Interest**

- 04/6/2018- #18-0169- Structure Fire- 1263 responded to a report of smoke in the building in the Town of Waukesha on an automatic aid request. 1263 was the second apparatus to arrive on scene and staged on scene while Town of Waukesha investigated.
- 04/07/2018- #18-0173- Large Outside Fire- Vernon was requested to respond to the Town of Burlington on the 3<sup>rd</sup> MABAS box for an engine respond for a change of quarters. 1261 responded to Tbfd station and was then requested to move to the scene. 1261 was then assigned to assist with fire attack and protect nearby houses.
- 04/22/2018- #18-200- Structure Fire- Vernon was requested to respond to Mukwonago on the first MABAS box for one squad direct to the scene. 1276 assisted with fire attack and overhaul.
- 04/26/2018- #18-208- Structure Fire- Vernon was requested to respond to Muskego on the first MABAS box alarm for one engine direct to the scene. 1263, 1201, 1202, 1204 responded direct to the scene. 1263 was assigned to assist with fire attack on one of two fully involved barns. All chief assisted the incident commander.
- 04/30/2018- #18-0216- Structure fire- Vernon 1292 and 1201 were requested automatic aid to New Berlin for a structure fire. 1292 assisted in the water shuttle and dumped water twice. 1201 was assigned to the operations position of the incident.
